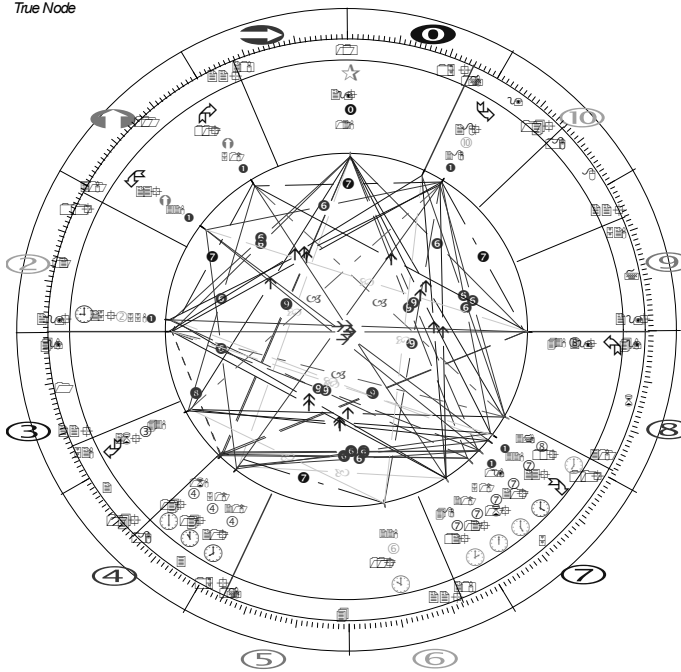

Hillary By Carole Devine

We knew it was coming. Hillary Clinton is running for president. As always in these election years, I feel an obligation to delineate the charts of the competitors. It is hard to predict the outcome of these things based on the candidates' charts because, as my teacher, Gina, used to say, when you are running for president it is a high point in the career, and all of them look like winners.

Hillary was born October 26, 1947 at 8:00 pm in Chicago. There is some controversy about the time, but if it was at 8:00 pm, there are some interesting factors at work. The 29th degree of mutable signs is considered "fated" and somewhat sacrificial— especially the 29th degree of Pisces. Hillary has the Moon at that point, plus 29 degrees of Gemini rising, and Juno at 29 degrees of Sagittarius. Those are all mutable signs.

Juno is the asteroid representing the "married woman," and Sagittarius is a sign that looks at the big picture—politics particularly. She has Juno exactly on the seventh cusp (marriage) and opposite the ascendant and square the Moon, which we already mentioned is in the fated, sacrificial degree of 29 Pisces. This would be a natural tendency to sacrifice her own happiness in marriage for the good a higher ideal. With Gemini being the rising sign, it is not at all surprising that she is a good communicator, and that she can reach the emotions of the masses, since the Moon in Pisces bestows compassion for the downtrodden and underprivileged.



It is not surprising that she is not recognized for this. We get our personalities across by communicating. What we say and how we say it reveals volumes about who we are, or rather, it influences how we are perceived. Most of Hillary's chart is about communication. First, Gemini, the communicator's sign is rising. Uranus is also rising, and it rules the ninth which is public communication, publishing, public speaking, etc. Uranus rising has some unique qualities, though. It is one of the indicators of a misunderstood person. (I know about that; I've lived with it myself in my own chart.) People with this have an innate belief that they can be whomever they please and do not categorize others. Therefore, they don't expect to be categorized. Imagine the shock when finding out that the opposite is how the rest of the world operates! There is fierce individuality with this position and a kind of loner persona. In addition there is much ability to ride waves of change easily. In fact, change is welcomed. Uranus hates to be bored.

Another communications indicator is the third house, Gemini's "home." Hillary has three planets there, and they are all the "tough guys"—Mars, the warrior, Pluto, the transformer, and Saturn, the disciplinarian. This is what she has to work with in terms of "style." It indicates a very probing, serious and aggressive mind. No nonsense is the order of the day. To add to this, it is all square Mercury in Scorpio in the fifth. Mercury in Scorpio, alone, is probing, and in the fifth there is a sense of drama. Knowing when to pause, when to wait for effect. The tightest square, though, is to Saturn, which is a tendency to depression. In addition the three planets in the third (Mars, Pluto and Saturn) are in Leo, which is an indication that she is proud, dignified and feels a certain entitlement. The three are also square Venus. This is another probing, intense and uncompromising trait. If she compromises, it is usually because there is something else more important.

On the plus side, she has Jupiter in Sagittarius, which is a high regard for honesty, but she is, after all, a Scorpio, and even though she is most likely honest in what she chooses to say, she is also secretive and private.

A Good President?

But what kind of leader would she make? If toughness is a prerequisite, she is that. She is also very dignified and able to hold her own in anyone's company. The only thing is that the Moon is square Uranus, and there is a certain amount of impulsiveness in that—over-reactive. This would be particularly apparent in regard to issues with foreign countries. It isn't temper as much as it's abrupt, sudden changing of direction. Unstable. It is modified by many other things in the chart, but still is something she has probably had to deal with all her life.

She is just going through her second Saturn return—a turning point in anyone's life. The upcoming eclipses are affecting her chart dramatically, but, most likely they are affecting all the candidates' charts. They are affecting hers, however, on the angles, which is far more potent. If she does become president, the good thing is that Saturn is leaving potent positions when she would take office. Bush had it just beginning to affect him. Neptune would also be leaving the field of influence, whereas with Bush it has been affecting him all along. This would make her term much easier.

Folks may wish to take note that Daylight Savings Times in the U.S. have changed, beginning in 2007. As a conservation measure, Daylight Savings will begin three weeks earlier than past years and end three weeks later. For 2007 the dates are Sunday, March 11 and ending on Sunday November 4. For 2008, Daylight Savings begins on Sunday, March 9 and ends on Sunday November 2.
